<b>Sentier dans le Vigne Rouge, Vaucluse, France</b>	£5.25	£6.95	£21.00
<i>A warming Rhône style red with rich spiced fruit aromas, ample round fruit on the palate and gentle tannins.</i>			
<b>Les Terrasses Merlot/Syrah, France</b>	£5.25	£7.40	£21.75
<i>Delightfully fruity, plummy Southern French Merlot-Syrah blend from the Ardeche.</i>			
<b>Bellefontaine, Cabernet Sauvignon, France</b>	£5.30	£7.50	£22.00
<i>A medium bodied Cabernet Sauvignon from the Valle Central, with aromas of ripe cherries and cassis and strawberries. Round, juicy tannins and an intense yet elegant finish.</i>			
<b>Carignan Vieilles Vignes, Mont Rocher, France</b>			£25.00
<i>This juicy wine has a beautiful cherry red colour. The nose shows an abundance of intense red berry fruit and hints of vanilla flavours. The palate is soft and full flavoured with a smooth easy drinking finish.</i>

<i>Quite ripe blackcurrant and wild berry fruits on the nose with a hint of grassy herbs, full bodied black fruits balanced by a slight grip and soft tannins.</i>

<i>Selected from the exclusive vineyards near Franschoek where the climate is mild with misty mornings and sunny days. A soft and well-rounded blend with outstanding berry fruit flavours.</i>

<i>Rich and spicy with an almost black olive character giving a savoury edge to the redcurrant, cherry and dark plum fruit. An exceptionally soft and well-rounded wine with smooth tannins.</i>

<i>Classic Rioja, red fruits and spices, liquorice with minimal new oak. Intense cherry red colour, ripe black and red fruits, and chocolate aroma. Round, well-balanced with fruit notes.</i>

<i>Black aromatic Malbec with succulent character. Darkly appealing, chocolatey with an abundance of crisp, mineral fruit and Morello cherry compote.</i>

<i>True to a well-made modern Côtes-du-Rhône – excellent value for money. Notes of spice and vanilla with plummy fruit in an elegant style.</i>

<i>Bodegas Ondarre was founded in 1985, with the aim of creating wines which showcase the region`s distinct terroirs. The Reserva`s are Bodegas Ondarre`s most acclaimed wines, which win top awards and critical approval every year. Leather, vanilla and spice of traditionally made Rioja enveloped in a smooth and textured palate.</i>			
<b>Fleurie `Clos des Deduits`, Manoir du Carra, France</b>			£39.00
<i>Built in the 18th century, situated in the Heart of Fleurie covering 9 hectares of granite based soil. This gorgeous Fleurie is full flavoured and deliciously soft with a rich warm aftertaste.</i>			
<b>Pinot Noir, Alberca Single Vineyard, Chilean</b>			£27.00
<i>Vibrant raspberry and red cherry fruit lifts effortlessly out of the glass. The palate is rich yet delicate, with a weight and finish that leaves you in no doubt that this is a classy, hand-crafted wine.</i>			
<b>Barbera d`Asti `Ceppi Storici`, Italy</b>			£29.00
<i>Spicy aromas of blueberries and plums, with subtle, smoky notes. The palate combines generous ripe fruit with lively acidity, with juicy cherry characters and spicy notes beneath.</i>			





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
